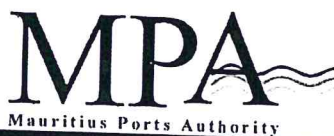

The Mauritius Ports Authority (MPA) is pleased to invite sealed bids from local and overseas bidders for the Corrosion Protection to Quay Structures at Port Louis Harbour as morefully described in the bidding document.

The scope of works includes inter-alia:

- Supply of aluminium anodes complete with fixing brackets, etc. to be fixed to the tubular piles & sheet piled wall of the various Quay Structures at Terminals I & II at Port Louis Harbour and to the sheet piled wall at Port Mathurin in Rodrigues.
- Remove marine growth and scaling and prepare surfaces to receive aluminium anodes
- To Install anodes as detailed in the Drawings.

Submission of bids

One original and 2 copies of the bid (in hard copies only) must be submitted in accordance with the Instruction to Bidders in sealed envelopes, clearly marked "**MPA 344(a)/2017- Corrosion Protection to Quay Structures at Port Louis Harbour.**" addressed to the Director General, Mauritius Ports Authority, 1st Floor, H. Bid Security

Bidders shall submit a Bid Security in the amount of **MUR 1,000,000 or USD 27,800 or EURO 25,700** in the format specified at Section III Bidding Forms of the Bidding Document. The bid security shall be in the form of an unconditional bank guarantee issued by a recognized commercial bank in Mauritius or a foreign bank through a correspondent bank located in Mauritius.

Bids not secured as above shall be rejected.
