The Mauritius Cane Industry Authority (MCIA), a parastatal body falling under the aegis of the Ministry of Agro-Industry and Food Security, invites potential national and international bidders with expertise and experience to submit Expression of Interest for the supply of Spectroscopy Equipment to MCIA.

The equipment will be used in the setting up of a Soil-Plant Spectral Analytical Unit at the Mauritius Sugarcane Industry Research Institute (MSIRI) of MCIA, based on Fourier Transform Mid-Infra Red (FT-MIR) Spectroscopy and portable X-ray Fluorescence (pXRF) Spectroscopy.

The items of equipment/services to be supplied are:

- 1. Bruker Alpha FT-IR spectrometer with diffuse reflectance accessory plus Reflectance module for contactless measurement with extended focus
- 2. Bruker AXS Handheld Tracer 5i SD X-ray fluorescence spectrometer

The combined FT-IR and pXRF system should be capable of determining soil physico-chemical properties (soil texture, moisture and water holding capacity, pH, electrical conductivity, total and potentially mineralizable nitrogen, phosphorus and potassium, organic carbon, exchangeable cations and cationic exchange capacity and total concentration of heavy metals) as well as total elemental concentrations of macro and micro nutrients in plant tissue.

The setting up this Spectral Analytical Unit will be done in collaboration with the Soil-Plant Spectral Diagnostics Laboratory, International Centre for Research in Agroforestry (ICRAF), Nairobi, Kenya, which also supports a network of infra-red spectroscopy national laboratories for low cost, high throughput soil and plant analysis in Africa. The protocols and calibrations developed by ICRAF are specific to certain makes, models and specifications of spectrometer equipment and cannot be transferred to other makes or models of instruments.
